"I had been requesting prayer for months for God to deliver me from my current job and to bless me with a new job. I was working six days a week with no work-life balance.



DONT BE PUSHED INTO A MOLD...

Be Transform

TODAY, AS WE LOOK AT SOCIETY AND AT WHAT IS CONSIDERED "THE NORM," IT SEEMS TO ME, PEOPLE WANT TO PUT US IN SOME KIND OF A MOLD...A MOLD OF HOW WE THINK, OF WHAT WE DO, AND EVEN HOW WE ACT AND REACT IN MANY SITUATIONS ...

Sometimes it may seem as if we are being pushed or pressured into conforming to what *they* think we should all be, sort of a generic or cookie-cutter version of mankind...all the same, with no one person or group having anything unique about them. And when we hear the term "they say"...who is "they" anyway? Instead of "they say", let's explore this from God's perspective...

God's Word says in Romans 12:2 NKJV... "And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind." The New Living Translation of the Bible says it this way... Don't copy the behavior and customs of this world, but let God transform you into a new person by changing the way you think. Then you will learn to know God's will for you, which is good and pleasing and perfect.

Let's look at the two words "conformed" and "transformed" from the New Kings James version.

If you are conforming to something, it's like you are taking on the shape of that thing...you're matching it...fitting into it...agreeing with it. It's like when modeling clay is shaped and molded into a specific piece of art. Or, as I have experienced



growing up, it's like when Grandma brought a Jello mold at Thanksgiving or Christmas dinner. The Jello "sat up" or was conformed to the shape of the mold it was poured into.

Paul is cautioning us in Romans 12:2 to not be conformed to the things of this world. We're not to follow or imitate or try to "fit in" to them...their ways, their speech, their actions...their ideas of "the norm." Sometimes these things can be contrary to God's ways of doing and being. Instead, we are to be "transformed," and we do that by regularly renewing our minds with God's Word. The metamorphic power of God's Word—the transforming power of God—can put you in a place where you can become that beautiful, graceful butterfly just waiting to soar; to fly high into the things God has created you to do and to be.

The word "transformed" in the verse above is like the word metamorphosis or when a caterpillar morphs into a beautiful butterfly. So, let me encourage you today... If you feel as if the world has tried to make you believe that you'll always be that little worm (like the beginning or "unfinished" stage of the butterfly) who seemingly has no potential to be anything other than a worm... If you've been made to believe that you'll never rise above your circumstances, or there's nothing unique about you, or that you have no potential to ever be anything but some kind of worm waiting to be metaphorically squashed, so to speak, by

the harshness of the world... I have good news! And that's what the Gospel is often referred to as—the Good News!

First of all, God made you to be exceptional, irreplacable, and unique in every way. In fact, no other person on the entire planet has your exact fingerprints. Secondly, God made you to "rise up as on eagle's wings" (Isaiah 40:31), to be "the head and not the tail" (Deuteronomy 38:13), and to "do all things through Christ who gives you strength" (Philippians 4:13).

You can be transformed. The metamorphic power of God's Word—the transforming power of God—can put you in a place where you can become that

beautiful butterfly just waiting to soar; to fly high into the things God has created you to do and to be.

So, starting today, let's begin to heed Paul's teaching in Romans 12:2 to us as believers and to indeed be spiritually correct—correct in our thinking, correct in our speech, and correct in our actions according to the Word of God... "transformed" by the Truth of God.

And, expect what Jeremiah 1:12 says, "I will hasten My word to perform it."

I pray for you to be blessed today. I pray you to declare, "2023 is the year for me." And I pray for you to say it and believe that it's the year for you. I pray for you to be healed from the crown of your head to the souls of your feet and for you to walk in all that God has for you, starting right now. I pray for your physical healing. I pray for your soul... your mind, will and emotions. I pray for your job. I pray for relationships. I pray for whatever it is that God has for you to come to pass—exceedingly, abundantly, far above anything you dare ask or think.

EASY CHEESY BREAKFAST BAKE

Ideas for Easter brunch!

INGREDIENTS:

1 pkg. refrigerated hash browns 1/4 cup melted butter

1 cup diced ham

8-oz. cheddar and jack cheese, shredded

1 can diced green chiles (optional)

2 eggs

1/2 cup milk

1/4 tsp. salt

DIRECTIONS

Put hash browns in greased pie pan; brush with butter.

Bake at 425° for 25 minutes.

Remove from oven; add ham, cheese, and chiles on top of hashbrowns.

Combine eggs and milk; pour over ham, cheese, and chiles.

Bake at 350° for 35 minutes.

BUTTERMILK PANCAKES

INGREDIENTS

PANCAKES:

1 egg

1 1/4 cups buttermilk

2 Tbsp. oil

1 cup all-purpose flour

1 tsp. sugar

2 tsp. baking powder

1/2 tsp. baking soda

1/2 tsp. salt

Fruit or nuts (optional)

TOPPINGS:

Blueberries, strawberries, nuts, maple syrup, whipped cream



DIRECTIONS

In a small bowl, beat egg with a fork. Beat in buttermilk and oil; set aside. In a large bowl, combine flour, sugar, baking powder, baking soda, and salt. Add egg mixture to dry ingredients. Stir the mixture until blended, but slightly lumpy. Add fruit or nuts if desired.

Pour 1/4 cup batter for each pancake onto lightly greased griddle. When you see small bubbles form, flip. Makes 8 or 9 pancakes.

(Caution using hot ingredients and griddle)

There are many tombs on this earth that still hold the remains of the dead. But there is an **EMPTY** tomb because it couldn't hold Jesus' body more than three days!

Every Easter is a special time of year to me because the world slows down to think again of how the Son of God, after dying on Calvary, rose from that tomb.

Many doubt, some sneer, but to us who believe we know that we know our Savior is risen!

Let me remind you that everything Jesus was in the flesh, and all He accomplished on the cross for our salvation, healing and prosperity in God, was in that tomb with Jesus. The evil men little knew their own hope of deliverance went with the dead body of Jesus as they took His crucified form down from the cross and put it in the tomb. But God knew, the angels knew, and on that third morning God sent an angel to roll away the stone.

When Jesus came out of the winding sheets of the dead, in one

swift move of the touch of the Holy Spirit, and stood exulting, "Because I live, you shall live also," He had you and me in mind.

All our sins, all our sicknesses and diseases, all our fears and torments, all our discouraging moments and defeated hopes, all our present and future —were in His hands when He rose with the glory of heaven and earth in His glorious new body.

Right there, long before you and I were born, our opportunity to rise into newness of life was put into full and final motion.


So, today, I want to pray a prayer of faith and stand with you against cancer. The Bible says, "If two shall agree on earth as concerning anything that
