about looking at battles in the Bible. He said the battlefield is not the place to do nothing, but the place to do something. He

said miracles generally require the good fight of your faith (1Timothy 6:12). And we can fight the good fight of our faith by declaring His Word. Faith comes by hearing and hearing by the word of God (Romans 10:17). As we hear and act on the Word of God, we can begin to stir up our most holy faith. Rather than simply



reacting on what we feel, we can respond according to what God said. Hebrews 11:1 says faith is the substance of things hoped for even though the evidence has not yet been seen.

Think of faith like God's monetary system. In our natural world money is the medium of exchange for goods and services. In the spirit world I believe our faith is what God recognizes and we have a Bible right to exchange our faith for God's reward (Hebrews 11:6).

Ephesians 6 tells us to put on *the whole armor of God* (not pieces, not parts, but the whole armor) and when we do, it prepares us for a battle in a way that is unique only to God. I believe that now more than ever, we have a Bible right to receive all that's in the Bible. As we stretch out our faith and expect a miracle, we can declare and decree the Word of God and expect it to come to pass according to God's timing.



STOP Devaluing PRAYER

ecently, while I was sound asleep, the Lord woke me up and talked to me about what we value and what we devalue. It was one of the strongest

impressions I've ever had in my life. And the Lord said, "Tell people, *stop devaluing prayer*." And He included me in this message. Wow! If He said to stop, it must mean that I was doing something that needed to change.

That was personal to me, meaning *Lindsay pay attention to what I'm saying*. I felt that there was something else coming, and that I'm not realizing all of God's power that's available to me. Richard always says, "Prayer is the key that unlocks the throne of God's mercy." And I really believe the saying, "Little prayer, little power. More prayer, more power. Much prayer, much power."

Praying with power

I felt like I needed to increase my level of expectation with prayer. So I looked up "**expect**" in the dictionary. It means to "*regard as likely to happen, believe something will arrive soon.*"

Then I looked up "**faith**". It means "...complete trust or confidence in someone or something, strong belief in God." Then I got the biblical definition of **faith**...."the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things **not yet** seen." (Hebrews 11:1)

I also looked up the word "miracle" in the Oxford Dictionary which said "... surprising and welcome event that is not explicable by natural or scientific laws, and therefore considered to be the work of divine agency". Strongs Interlinear online dictionary says miracle is "a sign, a wonder, as a special display of God's power." The spiritual side, the biblical side, is pointing us to being in God's care.

You can rely on the unchanging Word of God.

God was showing me, "Lindsay, you're going to see flip-flops between the world's view of things and God's view of things. You're going to see flip-flops in the economy. You're going to see flip-flops in the food shortages and the price of gas. You're going to see flipflops even in the way events are actually reported." The Bible says, "I'm the Lord. I change not." And I believe God was cautioning me to be careful not to lean to the world but rely on the unchanging Word of God. I had to carefully value and not devalue prayer by using my belief system, my faith, which comes by hearing the Word of God. In doing that, I believe it changes what we think. It changes what we believe and the way we pray.

It's the way of the world verses the way of the Word. W-O-R-L-D. W-O-R-D. The only difference is one little L. But that one little L can change your entire perspective on how everything is viewed.

I want to make absolute certain beyond any shadow of a doubt that according to 2 Corinthians 10:4-5, I'm "Casting down imaginations, and every high thing that exalts itself against the knowledge of God, and bringing into captivity every thought into the obedience of Christ."

Things can be increasing in the positive and things can be increasing in the negative, but I believe it all comes down to **faith being the substance of things that we are hoping for** (Hebrews 11:1).

I am not going to devalue prayer. I'm going to pray more than ever. "Pray without ceasing," (1 Thessalonians 5:17). Matthew 7:7 in the Amplified version says, "Ask and keep on asking. Seek and keep on seeking."

Faith comes by hearing the Word of God.

I believe we have to get to the place that, no matter what we see, no matter what we hear, no matter what we think, no matter what we feel, we can expect a miracle. How? Well, for starters, we have to increase our prayer life, increase our Bible life, because *faith comes by hearing the Word of God.*

So I am going to increase my prayer life. I am going to

MYDC RECIPES

CHLOE'S COFFEE CAKE

INGREDIENTS:

MIX together the following: 1 cup all-purpose flour 1⁄2 teaspoon baking powder 1⁄2 teaspoon baking soda 1/3 teaspoon salt 1⁄2 cup brown or maple sugar 1⁄2 teaspoon cinnamon 1 egg

ADD the following: 1 stick soft butter ½ teaspoon vanilla ½ cup non-fat yogurt 1 large apple (peeled and cubed)

TOPPING ¼ cup maple or brown sugar ¼ cup maple syrup pecans (chopped)

DIRECTIONS

MIX first set of ingredients together in a mixing bowl.

ADD the second set of ingredients to the mixing bowl and MIX well. SPRAY 9" round baking pan with cooking spray and POUR mixture into pan.

MIX together topping ingredients in a separate bowl and SPREAD over top of the cake.

BAKE at 350 degrees for 25 to 30 minutes or until toothpick inserted comes out clean.

CABBAGE ROLLS

INGREDIENTS:

head cabbage
 lb. lean ground beef
 1/2 cups long grain rice
 tsp. cinnamon
 tsp. garlic powder
 tsp. salt
 tsp. onion powder
 1/2 tsp. pepper
 tsp. allspice
 (14 1/2-oz) can diced tomatoes
 cups tomato juice
 Tbsp. olive oil
 garlic cloves (leave whole)
 1/8 cup lemon juice
 tsp. mint leaves

SAUCE TOPPING: 1/2 tsp. mint 1 tsp. salt 1/2 tsp. garlic 1/2 tsp. cinnamon

DIRECTIONS

Core cabbage (leaving cabbage whole). In large pot, bring 5 quarts of water to a boil. Place entire head of cabbage into water; blanch, removing leaves as they separate from the head. Place cabbage on cookie sheet to drain and cool. In mixing bowl, combine meat, rice, and seasonings; mix well. Place approximately 2 Tbsp. of meat mixture into each cabbage leaf; roll securely. Put whole garlic cloves and 3 Tbsp. olive oil in bottom of Dutch oven. Arrange all of the cabbage rolls in the pot tightly, so they cannot unroll. Pour 4 cups tomato juice, tomatoes, and lemon juice over top of cabbage rolls. Sprinkle sauce topping spices on top of cabbage rolls. Bring to a boil; reduce heat to medium low, and cover. Cook for 30-45 minutes, until cabbage is tender.* Let stand 15-20 minutes before serving. (Recipe from MYDC archives. Thank you Barbie Letney!)



Expecting the UNEXPECTED

I WANT TO SHARE FOUR BIBLICAL KEYS THAT CAN HELP YOU RELEASE YOUR FAITH AND EXPECT THE UNEXPECTED...

BE ANXIOUS FOR NOTHING, BUT IN EVERYTHING BY PRAYER AND SUPPLICATION, WITH THANKSGIVING, LET YOUR REQUESTS BE MADE KNOWN TO GOD; AND THE PEACE OF GOD, WHICH SURPASSES ALL UNDER-STANDING, WILL GUARD YOUR HEARTS AND MINDS THROUGH CHRIST JESUS. -Philippians 4:6-7

Key 1 – Don't worry but pray.

The Bible says not to worry about anything, but instead pray about everything. I want to remind you of what the apostle Paul said to his young protege, Timothy... For God has not given us a spirit of fear, but of power and of love and of a sound mind (2 Timothy 1:7). You don't have to spend your life fretting and worrying and wringing your hands and expecting the expected. With God, you can expect the unexpected!

Key 2 – Have faith in God.

Use the faith God gave you according to Romans 12:3 which says that God has given to every person THE measure of faith. It says that God has given the

measure, not *a* measure, of faith. And that's all the faith you need. You didn't get saved without faith. We are saved by grace through faith (Ephesians 2:8–9). Faith is your belief system and as you exercise it according to God's Word, you can expect God to respond. And remember... Without faith it is impossible to please Him, for he who comes to God must believe that He is, and that He is a rewarder of those who diligently seek Him (Hebrews 11:6). And in 1 John 5:4... For whatever is born of God overcomes the world. For this is the victory that has overcome the world—our faith. You have faith. When you exercise your faith or "act on" your faith, it's like saying to God that you trust Him to act on His Word and carry it out in your life. I've said faith is like muscles. You have muscles, but how they develop can be a direct result of exercise. As we exercise our faith, it gives that faith an opportunity to increase.

Key 3 – Eagerly anticipate the Holy Spirit to move on your

behalf. I heard someone say it is just as easy to believe God as it is to doubt Him. So why not just try believing God's Word? Get into expectation. Each time my wife, Lindsay, was pregnant, carrying our children into her last stage of pregnancy, she would always begin organizing things in preparation for the baby's birth. She was expecting, right? She was in expectation of our baby, so she was acting on her faith for what was to come. Now, that's expectation in the natural. In the Spirit, in God's kingdom, we can learn to live in a state of expectation for God's miracles. Expect God to move in your life supernaturally by His power within you... Now the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace in believing, that ye may abound in hope, through the power of the Holy Ghost (Romans 15:13 K[V).

Key 4 – Remember, God said He will never leave you or

forsake you. God is with you. He said, "I will never leave you, nor forsake you" (Hebrews 13:5). He's not just with you, He's within you by the power of the Holy Spirit. If you're a born-again believer in Jesus Christ, you have an opportunity to tap into the power and presence of God through the Holy Spirit. He's the Divine Paraclete, the One not only called to be alongside you to help you out, but to be in you. And when you gave your heart to Christ, when you were saved, the Holy Spirit came in and took up residence in your heart. You have the presence of the Greater One, Jesus, living inside you (1 John 4:4). You are never alone. God said to Isaac, "I'll be with you." He told Jacob, "I'll be with you." He told Joseph, "I'll be with you," and on down the line. If we listen with our heart, I believe that He's telling you, today, "I'll be with you." And, so, you have a Bible right, in faith, to expect a miracle...to expect the unexpected.

Editor's Note: Oral Roberts shared this message in the year 2000, and we believe it is very timely for the unusual days in which we live.

oney has many purposes—and it can have a spiritual purpose and mission if we use it as the Lord directs us to use it. I believe God's people must be a part of a transfer of wealth into the hands of righteous people in order to fulfill Scripture and send out the *teaching, preaching, healing Gospel* of Jesus Christ as a witness to the nations in the end times.

Matthew 4:23–25 says, Jesus went about all Galilee, teaching in their synagogues, and preaching the gospel of the kingdom, and healing all manner of sickness and all manner of disease among the people. And his fame went throughout...and there followed him great multitudes.

Those people were not just following the man Jesus. They were following the One who taught, who preached, and who healed—the One who could deliver them out of their distresses.

I see a remnant of believers who are into the teaching, preaching, and healing message of Jesus Christ. And according to Proverbs 13:22, a portion of the finances of the

world are going to be loosed into their hands in the endtime transfer of wealth so they can do it.

In Exodus 12:35–36, the Lord gave the children of Israel favor with the Egyptians and had jewels of silver, and jewels of gold, and raiment transferred into their hands the night of their exodus from Egypt.

Perhaps, they didn't understand the purpose for the money at the time, but later in Exodus 25:8 we see the purpose. God said, "Build me a sanctuary—a place where I can dwell." They used the riches to build it.

Now, God was not just talking about church buildings here. When someone can turn on their television and get born again and have Jesus move into their heart—a sanctuary where He can dwell—it's because of Christians' money that provided the equipment and the television time.

Jesus said in Matthew 24:14: This gospel of the kingdom shall be preached in all the world for a witness unto all nations; and then shall the end come. Living in a preacher's home, I can remember hearing my father say, "Christ may come today." Many years have passed since then, and Christ still hasn't come because there are still places in the world that have not been presented with the Gospel of Jesus Christ! I have personally been in 70 nations during my ministry, bringing the healing power of

God. Many, many others have gone too, but still, not all have heard.

The Bible says the Gospel must be confirmed with signs and wonders to capture the attention of the multitudes. For example, in 1954 we brought television cameras into our big tent crusades for the first time, where each night there were as many as 10,000 people inside the tent, plus those standing outside. So many were there because we were praying for the sick, and the sick were being healed.

And we had it filmed! TV stations coast-to-coast and throughout Canada, Japan, and other nations carried the services, and millions of people watched miracles happen right before their eyes. But I want to tell you what I see happening in the future. God has always had

a remnant—a group of people to take the Gospel to the unsaved. And I see that remnant rising up and infiltrating the earth with the Gospel of Jesus Christ.

I envision huge outreaches being conducted with mass miracles taking place. And I see them being televised throughout the nations of the world, causing a witness so big, so powerful, that it will capture the attention of nations with the message that *Jesus saves, heals, and delivers!*

For outreaches like these to happen, we need to start believing God for finances and understanding that **giving has a purpose**—so God can open the windows of heaven and pour us out more than enough, according to Malachi 3:10–11. Then as our needs are met—as finances, resources, and workers are in place—we can send out the Gospel of Jesus Christ to all the nations as a witness.

Let me tell you, money is not the issue. The Word of God is the issue, and *what God is saying* is the issue. If we're true to the Word and are bold toward believing God for the finances to accomplish His directions, I believe the provision will come.

As we give, as we obey the Bible, I believe that a supernatural outpouring of finances can come to the body of Christ. Once that happens, more than ever before, I see Christians carrying the Gospel to the nations of the earth. As people listen to God, and the message of Jesus Christ is received, we can see the saving, healing Gospel come alive as never before.
