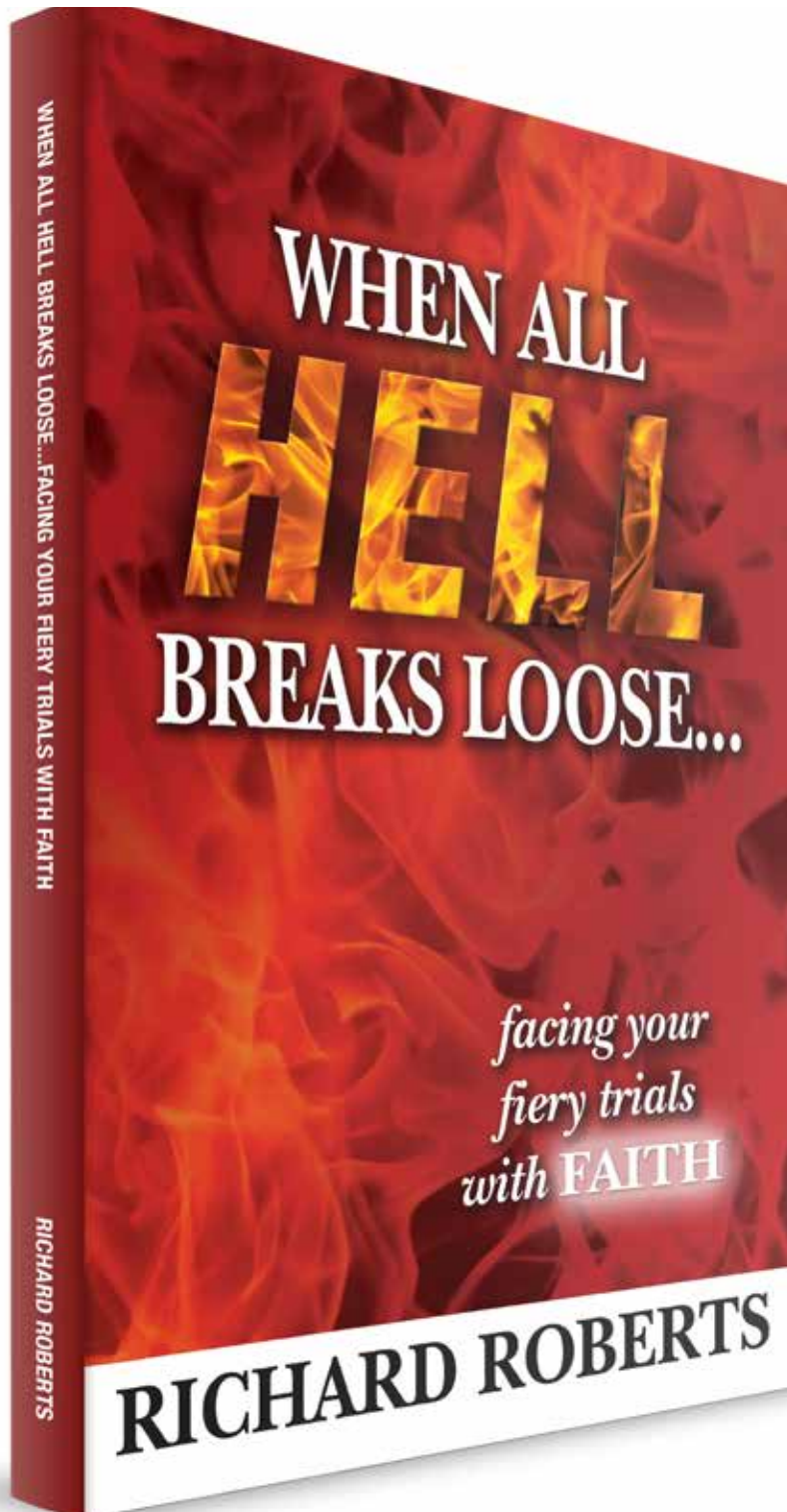

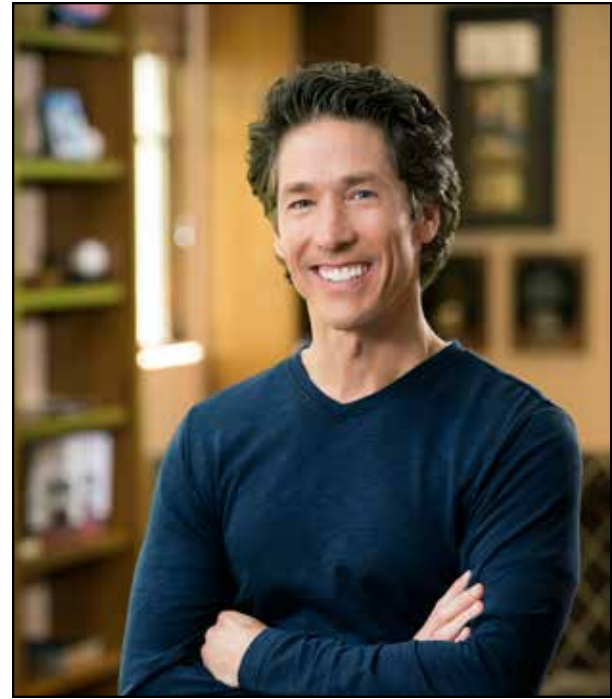

In May, the Oral Roberts Ministries conducted pastors conferences, evangelistic crusades, and medical clinics, as well as distributing food to orphanages in Kumasi, Ghana, West Africa. Here's a look at what your prayers and seed-faith gifts helped accomplish—and the people that you helped to touch with the power and love of Jesus Christ.

Sharing Christ with the People of Kumasi

Thousands of people attended the three evangelistic meetings, which took place in the Kumasi sports arena. After sharing God's Word and a time of healing prayer, Richard invited those who had a miracle to report to come forward. Many came forward to testify of their healings.

One lady said she was so happy to be free of back pain that she danced on stage. Another woman said she came to the nightly crusade meetings with pain in her hip. Doctors had told her that she would never walk. But after prayer, she said she was able to walk—without pain!

A man who was deaf in his ear for three years believed God for a miracle during Richard's prayers and words of knowledge. The man reported that after the prayer, he felt as if something popped out of his ear and he could hear perfectly well now, to the glory of God.

Richard then invited those who wanted to commit their lives to Christ to come to the front. Altar counselors were there to pray with everyone who wanted to make Jesus the Lord of their life. As Richard pointed out, "The greatest miracle of all is salvation!"

Ministry and Medicine for the Suffering

Three days of medical clinics were held in a local church convenient to the people of Kumasi. Volunteers came from many different Christian denominations to provide help with this outreach. During the clinics, our team of doctors and nurses, who donated their time to participate in this outreach, treated around 100 people each day.

Many people came to the clinics in pain from the hard manual labor they do each day. And many reported instant healings from the pain after our doctors and nurses prayed for them to be healed.

According to Dr. Gary Lee, “Back pain is a common problem [in Kumasi] from their manual labor jobs.” Many people also came in with symptoms of carpal tunnel syndrome. Doctors were able to teach these patients simple exer-

cises to stretch and strengthen their muscles.

Another common problem the doctors saw in the medical clinics was pterygium, an irritating eye condition caused by the amount of dust in the air. It can result in growths on the eye that cause discomfort. Some people who came to the clinics also had problems seeing clearly—which our doctors and nurses were able to help by handing out donated eyeglasses.

Many people also received Jesus as Lord and Savior during the clinics. The medical supplies left over after the clinics ended were donated to a teaching hospital in Kumasi, where doctors often treat the poor. The donated supplies will be given to patients who cannot afford to buy medicines.

Testimonies in the Medical Clinics

One of our nurses, Marinda, shares her experience at the clinics...

The three-day medical clinics were amazing! We were all in awe of God's amazing love and how easily the Holy Spirit manifested His anointing. And the people received Him so freely.

One woman I saw had a small convenience shop next door to the clinic. Her problem was severe lumbar pain, interfering with her ability to walk and stand comfortably. She received her healing after prayer, and we all saw her the very next day working in her shop, lifting things and standing without any problems. Another woman, Amina, confidently told us she wanted to receive Jesus Christ as her Lord and Savior.

Mary came to the clinic with so much lower back pain that she was unable to function well. After prayer, she was instantly healed of the back pain, and it was very obvious in her voice and countenance that she was free.

Everyone we met in Ghana had great respect for the Oral Roberts Ministries, and they were so grateful for the medications and ministry that we shared with them. We serve an amazing God!

In Kumasi, Richard taught in a three-day pastors conference, sharing Bible truths about the Holy Spirit and His role in our lives, the miracle of seed-faith living, and God's healing power—all messages that are not well-known in Africa. Around 2,000 ministers, pastors, and church leaders attended.

Make your words a Delight in God's sight

Did you know it is said that **men** speak around 7,000 words a day, but **women** speak nearly 20,000? That's a lot of opportunities for us to make our words match up with God's Word!

The Bible says in Psalm 19:14, *Let the words of my mouth, and the meditation of my heart, be acceptable in thy sight, O Lord, my strength, and my redeemer.* If we want the Lord to be our strength and our redeemer, then it's important to let the words of our mouth and the meditations of our heart be a delight to Him.

Let me ask you a question. If you're thinking **about** a situation, do you talk **to** the situation, or does the situation talk to you? Do you talk **about** your problems, or do you talk **to** the problems and speak God's Word into the situation? I believe that we have control over our words, and if we don't line them up with the Word of God, then the cares of the day can start taking control over us instead of the other way around.

I believe our words are like a bank account. We must spend them wisely. The Bible very clearly talks about the power of our words to bring something to pass. Remember, Proverbs 18:21 tells us that death and life are in the power of the tongue. Are we bringing negative things to pass with our words, or are we

bringing positive things to pass? Are we bringing doom and gloom into our lives by our words, or do we use our words to build ourselves and others up?

When I was preparing to go to law school, I had to take classes on probability and statistics. One of the things we learned about was called “**if-then**” suppositions. **If** this happened, **then** this would be the outcome. If this did not happen, then this would not be the outcome. As soon as “A” happened, something would directly happen to “B.” I was intrigued because I love mathematics and all things logical. Two plus two always equals four. Well, when you look at this concept, these suppositions were always the same. If “A” happened, “B” happened. If “A” did not happen, then “B” would not happen.

In my opinion, the Bible is actually a series of many “**if-then**” suppositions. For example, 2 Chronicles 7:14 says, ***If** my people, which are called by my name, shall humble themselves, and pray, and seek my face, and turn from their wicked ways; **then** will I hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin, and will heal their land.*

If my people... will humble themselves and pray, **then**... I will heal their land. Now look at Psalm 37: ***If** we delight ourselves in the Lord, **then** He can give us the desires of your heart. When we do our part, God can begin to do His part.*

So, a good question to ask is, have we done our part of the equation? Did we whine, gripe, and complain, or did we delight ourselves in the Lord? The Bible

doesn't say we're to give praise **for** the situation. But it does say that **in** the midst of the situation, we're to give praise to God, Who is bigger than our situation.

And so, as we begin to praise God in the midst of the mess, God can begin to inhabit our praises, according to Psalm 22:3. I believe with all my heart that as God comes on the scene, things begin to change. How can God begin to change things until we do our part and speak His Word in faith and prayer, expecting Him to do what He has promised to do for us?

Perhaps the best friend you'll ever have is the one who will not let you get away with saying something in contrast to the Word of God. My precious husband, Richard, will let me vent my frustrations for a little while and then he'll look at me and say, “Okay, now what does God say?” And you know what? He will force me to make a decision to either match my words to how I feel, or match my words to God's Word. As a Christian, that's a true friend!

So I ask you today, what are you saying? **How are you spending your words?** Remember, the Bible promises us that whatever a person sows, that—and only that—shall he also reap. If you sow into your situation with negative words, then why be shocked when negative things begin to happen? But if you sow with your words in line with the Word of God, then you can expect to see the outcome line up with the Word of God. I encourage you to make your words line up with His Words, and make your words a delight in His sight! ☺

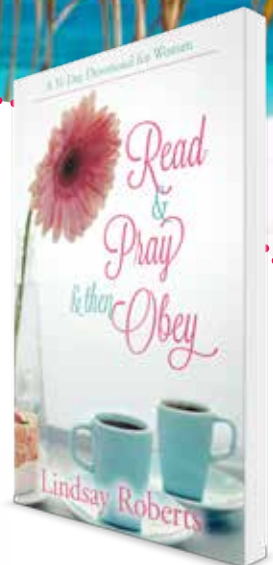

Radical miracles

*A few years ago, Lindsay and I became friends with a powerful young evangelist from Jacksonville, Florida, Brian Carn, who recently joined us on “The Place for Miracles.” I asked Brian to share his heart with Lindsay and me and our viewers. I believe what he shares regarding **Radical Miracles** will be a blessing in your life.*

Hebrews 11:6 says: *But without faith it is impossible to please God. He that cometh to God must first believe that he is, and that he is a rewarder of those who diligently seek him.* God will look in a room with millions of people and find that one person with faith and move on their behalf. I believe it takes faith to move the heart of God.

Let me explain it like this. If you break your leg, the doctor will say it's going to take 8–10 weeks to heal. But when you get where faith is in operation and the presence of God is strong, God can give you a miracle. Something that should have taken 8–10 weeks, God can do in less than a second. That is radical. Healing can take time, but miracles are more instant!

This is a time of miracles, and I believe God is doing something special in the Earth. I also believe this is a season of sacrifice. I was looking at John 12, where the woman laid the bottle of perfume at the feet of Jesus. The Bible calls it spikenard—a costly oil that took about one whole year’s wages to purchase. But it didn’t start there.

That story started in Bethany, a place where Jesus would hang out with His good friends, Mary, Martha and Lazarus. Whenever he wanted to be refreshed, he went to Bethany and spent time with them. But this time, Martha came to Him and said, “Lazarus, whom you love, is sick.” She expected Jesus to drop everything He was doing to go see Lazarus. But Jesus kept doing what He was doing. She came to Him again and said, “Lazarus is dead, and had you been here by now, he wouldn’t be dead.” Jesus told her that Lazarus was going to rise again and said, “Show me where you laid him.”

When Jesus got there, He spoke to Lazarus. And the man who lay there dead, who had already begun to decompose, was healed instantly. Just like that, a miracle! A word was spoken, and Lazarus got up out of that grave and began to walk.

But remember, as soon as that miracle came, Jesus’ critics began the plot to kill Him. Yet Jesus went on about His business and eventually came into Simon’s house. That is where the woman, Mary, laid the costly perfume at His feet.

Sometimes people hold back on their faith and on their giving. But right now I encourage you to make a radical sacrifice. What the woman in John 12 did was to make a radical sacrifice for a radical Savior. She took that oil and laid it at the feet of Jesus—a radical sacrifice.

Let me talk to you about that perfume—that perfume was not cheap. It was costly. It was pure. Most of the perfumes we wear now are watered down. If you look at the bottom of the bottle, it probably says Eau de Toilette, which means it is not pure perfume. But the sacrifice she gave Jesus was not a watered down sacrifice. She gave Him a pure sacrifice, a pure perfume.

Today, is the Lord asking you for a radical, pure sacrifice? We serve a radical Savior, and only He can give us a radical miracle.

Now I’d like to pray for you.
Father, in the name of Jesus, I curse lack, and ask for supernatural provision for these dear ones today. I come against every spirit that tries to hinder them. I pray that doors are opening now as they sow their increase. I thank You, God, for their radical sacrifice and the radical miracles that are coming their way, in the name of Jesus. Amen. ☪

RICHES do not equal *Treasure*

A CLASSIC MESSAGE BY ORAL ROBERTS



Luke 18:18–27 tells of the rich young ruler who came to Jesus and said, “Lord, what must I do to have eternal life?”

Jesus read the young man’s heart like an open book and knew what was wrong with him. It is a marvelous thing to me that Jesus Christ has never said a harmful word about money, but He has a lot to say about the way people use it. He said, “*Son, sell what you have and give to the poor. Come, take up your cross and follow Me, and you will have treasures in heaven.*” The young man went away sorrowfully, for he was very rich and had many possessions. Here is the distinction that Jesus makes between possessions and treasures: He says that material things are possessions, but that eternal life is a treasure.

The young fellow wanted life. Jesus saw that he was wrapped up in his money, and because of this, he was entrapped by material possessions. Money had become the young man’s master, and gold had become chains around his soul.

Jesus is saying in essence, “Son, give it up.” He would have said the same thing about any other **thing** that would have hindered the man’s life. It just so happened that in this case, the hindering factor was money.

Some people turn to alcohol to deal with their problems; some others turn to gambling, drugs or other addictions. A man who loves money is maybe as bad off as a man who loves these other addictions. There is a difference, of course, but in a sense, the principle is the same: the person is putting his trust in something that doesn’t last. Sometimes, when people read this passage of scripture, they think that money itself is bad, but that’s not true. Money, on its own, is one of the purest things in the world. It has no morality to it. It’s just an object.

Money becomes what the person is who has it. Money is as holy or as evil as the person who has that money. A man could be a billionaire and have Christ in his soul, right? And if he would honor Christ with that billion dollars, then the money is used for good, isn’t it? It’s all about how he uses the money.

Jesus said to the rich young ruler, “Son, give that up and you will have treasures.” What did He mean? He was simply saying, “Son, you don’t have any treasures. All you have is money.”

The man who has only money is maybe one of the poorest people in the world. If all he has is money, what can he buy? He can buy material goods, but he can’t buy love. He can’t buy friendship. He can’t buy health. He can’t buy peace of mind and peace of soul. He can’t buy a home in heaven.

What can he buy with his money? Groceries—he eats them up. Clothes—he wears them out. A car—he wears it out. What can he buy with money that will last for eternity? Nothing—because money can buy so little of the good things of life!

Folks, if you have an affliction that really has hold of you, what can be done? If money could buy health, the rich people would be the healthiest folks in the world.

Let me show you what I mean: A church deacon on a pair of crutches came in my healing line in the first meeting I conducted. He had become an arthritic case and had gone to a clinic and had remained there for several weeks. He had spent \$12,000 at the clinic to get well, and they finally pronounced him incurable.

He returned home where he heard of our meeting. *(Continued on next page)*

He hobbled into the meeting on crutches, came up in the healing line, and told me the story:

He had spent \$12,000 to be told he was incurable. Now, what was his money worth? It couldn't cure him or give him peace of mind.

The Spirit of God came on me. I laid my hand on his head and prayed for him. The power of the Lord came on his body. He gave me his crutches and went walking off, perfectly normal. His body was healed in one second by the power of God.

That is what God offers people—the things of God that money can't buy. And He also offers you all the things money can buy that you have need of, plus all the things that money can't buy. You can't

improve on the Lord!

When the young ruler walked off, sorrowful because he had many possessions, he must have wondered, "If I give up everything, what am I going to get out of it?"

Jesus said, *Every one that hath forsaken houses, or brethren, or sisters, or father, or mother, or wife, or children, or lands, for my name's sake shall receive in this life an hundredfold, and shall inherit everlasting life* (Matt. 19:29 KJV).

What do you receive? A hundredfold of life itself. You can have your dollars, but if you don't have life, peace of mind, and peace of soul, the possessions you have are maybe just dead-weight tied to your life. ☪

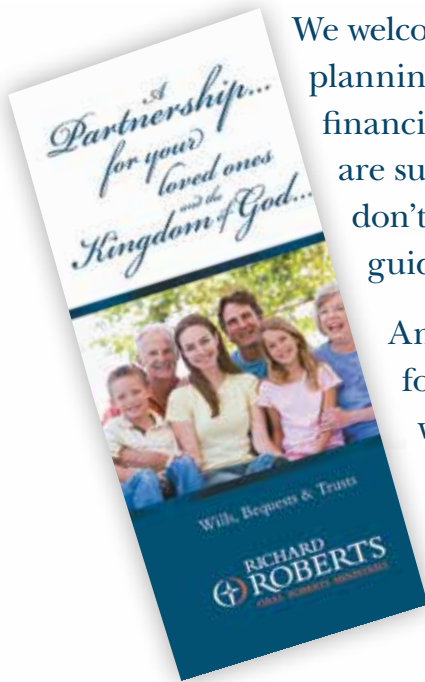
